Equal Pay Class Action Filed Against Vice Media Inc. and Vice Media LLC

February 13, 2018, the law firm of Alexander Krakow + Glick LLP filed a class action against Vice Media Inc. and Vice Media LLC (collectively “Vice”) on behalf of a former employee of Vice, and others similarly situated, alleging violations of California, New York, and federal statutes requiring equal pay between men and women. The lawsuit alleges that Vice pays its male employees at its Los Angeles and Brooklyn offices substantially more money than women performing the same or substantially similar work.

Michael Morrison said: “Our investigation has uncovered significant evidence that Vice made a conscious decision to pay more money to its male employees than its female employees who worked in similar positions performing the same or substantially similar work. This result is not surprising given the male dominated leadership structure at Vice and the public allegations of rampant gender discrimination and harassment as reported by the New York Times last year.”

The lawsuit seeks back pay on behalf of all female employees who were paid less than their male counterparts, liquidated damages, injunctive relief, and attorneys fees.
